Dear Mr. Ramirez and Mr. Magill:

As Co-Chairs of the Congressional Labor Caucus, we believe that fairness, respect, and dignity in the workplace are fundamental principles protected under the National Labor Relations Act. It is in that spirit that we write to urge Rinker Materials to return to the bargaining table and negotiate in good faith toward a fair and timely resolution of its ongoing labor dispute with Teamsters Local 631.

Since January 5, 2026, members of Teamsters Local 631 – workers who produce concrete pipe and box culverts critical to our nation’s infrastructure – have been on strike to secure protections for their health care, retirement benefits, and wages. Based on our understanding, negotiations have stalled after Rinker Materials proposed a contract with a series of concessions impacting health care coverage and retirement benefits. We are concerned that an extended stoppage could result in significant financial uncertainty for long-time employees, their families, and the broader community.


These workers have continued to express a willingness to bargain in good faith to reach a fair agreement that respects both their contributions and their long-term security. As you know, it is the policy of the United States under the National Labor Relations Act to encourage collective bargaining between workers and employers over the terms and conditions of employment. We therefore remain hopeful that both parties can return to productive negotiations and reach a resolution that is fair to all involved.

Please know that we will continue to monitor the situation closely and remain engaged as discussions move forward.


