Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I am requesting community project funding for Moapa Valley Water District in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is, Moapa Valley Water District, 601 N Moapa Valley Blvd, Moapa Valley, NV 89040.

The funding would be used to replace approximately 4.3 miles (22,600 feet) of a critical length of existing 24-inch potable water transmission line that has experienced a high leak/break rate. This project will prevent contamination in the distribution piping by eliminating the high failure rates being experienced in the system.

The project is a good use of taxpayer funds because it replace an existing 24-inch ductile iron transmission line that was installed in 1996 and has large sections that are beginning to degrade to the point that the District is expending considerable resources in repairs. The line is the primary trunk line that carries 75% of the culinary water to the towns of Logandale and Overton and is thus a piece of critical infrastructure; if the line were to fail catastrophically, it would severely limit the District's ability to serve water and fire protection to the community.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Section 1452 of the Safe Drinking Water Act, 42 U.S.C. 300j-12.
