I am requesting community project funding for U.S. 6, Tonopah Downtown Rehabilitation in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is Nevada Department of Transportation, 1263 Stewart St., Carson City NV 89712.

The funding would be used to provide safety enhancements to the community including shoulder widening, roadway reconstruction, construction of a new storm drain system, installation of technology to improve operational communications (ITS trunk line), and complete street elements. Implementing Complete Streets near the high school in Tonopah will enhance safety by adding separate space for road users. This project is a priority for the town of Tonopah and Nye County and provides safety and resilience.
