Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I am requesting community project funding for Kyle Canyon Rainbow Discharge Line in fiscal year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is, Las Vegas Valley Water District, 1001 S. Valley View Boulevard, Las Vegas, NV 89153.

The funding would be used to replace the existing discharge pipeline at Rainbow Well which is over 40 years old and at the end of its useful life. A portion of the pipeline is running above ground through a steep drainage channel prone to avalanche and flood activity. The pipeline supports have deteriorated over many years of flooding and ground movement. All of this threatens the stability of the existing pipeline, which if damaged would result in residents losing access to their primary source of drinking water. The project will install 3,400 linear feet of new underground pipeline to reliably serve the community, which is within the fourth congressional district of Nevada (NV-04), and minimize the risk of damage from erosion, drainage runoff, natural disasters, and falling trees.

The project is a good use of taxpayer funds because Mount Charleston has a total of 415 residents that will benefit from this project. The size of the population limits the amount of funding available for capital water projects, which has resulted in this project being delayed for more than four years.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C. 1383(c) (Section 603(c) of the Clean Water Act).
