I am requesting community project funding for Clark County Energy Resilience and Safety Project in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is Clark County at 500 S. Grand Central Pkwy, Las Vegas, NV 89155.

The funding would be used to fund this project will install LED lighting at 10 locations throughout Clark County. The project will have significant regional benefits throughout Clark County. This project will save energy and address outdoor lighting including parks, parking lots, area lighting, and ballfields. This project will impact low-income communities in Clark County. All the sites are located in low-income communities with LMI% above 51%. These locations also have an energy burden greater than 4 and an energy burden percentile greater than 70 percent.

The project is a good use of taxpayer funds because it will install LED lighting at 10 locations throughout Clark County, including a location in the fourth congressional district in Nevada (Fire Station 75 - 255 South Nevada St., Searchlight, NV 89045). This project involves removing and replacing outdoor metal halide lighting fixtures and replacing with LED fixtures using 50-80% less energy while improving safety and visibility in lowincome communities in Clark County.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(2).
