Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I am requesting community project funding for City of North Las Vegas - Losee Wash Diversion Project in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is City of North Las Vegas, 2250 Las Vegas Blvd N, Ste 700, North Las Vegas, NV 89030.

The funding would be used to fund the construction of a relief to limit sanitary sewer overflows and provide additional capacity to develop north and northwest portions of the city.

The project is a good use of taxpayer funds because the City of North Las Vegas Losee Wash Diversion Project (LWDP) will solve an urgent sewer infrastructure issue within the target area. Currently, two sewer mains converge in the Las Vegas Wash Channel at Gowan Road, between Losee Road and Civic Center Drive. This convergence creates a pinch point which causes overflow and spills into the community, releasing contaminants and creating a public health hazard. This urgent public health issue disproportionately effects the low-income and unhoused community within the surrounding area.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C. 1383(c) (Section 603(c) of the Clean Water Act).
