I am requesting funding for the Walnut Community Center and Park Lighting Improvement Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Clark County, located at 500 S Grand Central Parkway, Las Vegas, Nevada 89155. The funding would be used for to replace existing outdated exterior lighting with high-efficiency LED fixtures to improve safety, visibility, and reliability for community members while reducing energy consumption and long-term operating costs. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because LED lighting technology significantly reduces electricity consumption, extends fixture lifespan, and lowers long-term maintenance costs. The resulting operational savings will allow Clark County to redirect limited public resources toward additional community services while ensuring safer and more reliable public infrastructure for residents.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C.5305(a)(2).
